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*Everyone knows that change is risky, and the discipline of change management has developed to maximise the chances of successful change. But change remains challenging, and often fails to deliver the expected benefits.*

This presentation reviews the change process and exposes the points where it most often fails. Reasons for failure focus on lack of engagement of key stakeholders in the change. A structured approach to proactive stakeholder engagement is described, diagnosing the most risky stakeholders and using applied emotional literacy to influence them.
